

SHOE-HURLING ATTACK | The act elicits all-around condemnation

Shocked, but now it is forgotten chapter: CJI

Chief Justice of India B R Gavai on Thursday said he and Justice K Vinod Chandran were shocked when a lawyer attempted to hurl a shoe at him on October 6, but the issue is a "forgotten chapter." In an unprecedented and shocking incident, a 71-year-old lawyer, Rakesh Kishore, took his shoe in his hand and tried to hurl it at the CJI on Monday.

The CJI made the observation during the hearing of a batch of pleas seeking review and modification of the Vana-shakti judgement, which had prohibited the central government from granting retrospective or ex post facto environmental clearances to projects found violating environmental norms.

"My learned brother (Justice Chandran) and I were very shocked with what happened on Monday; for us it is a for-

gotten chapter," the CJI said on the shoe attack.

Justice Ujjal Bhuyan, who is sharing the bench, differed with the course of action adopted against the errant lawyer, and said, "I have my own views on this, he is the CJI, it is not a matter of joke!" Justice Bhuyan said the attack was "an affront to the Supreme Court" and due action should have been taken.

Solicitor General Tushar Mehta termed the act unpardonable.

SCBA terminates membership of Kishore

The Supreme Court Bar Association on Thursday terminated with immediate effect membership of lawyer Rakesh Kishore, who attempted to hurl a shoe towards Chief Justice of India B R Gavai inside the courtroom, after finding him guilty of "grave misconduct".

Athawale seeks action under SC/ST Act

Union minister Ramdas Athawale on Thursday demanded that a case under the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act should be registered against the man who tried to throw a shoe at Chief Justice of India B R Gavai. The incident took place because some people from the upper caste community could not come to terms with the fact that Gavai, who is from the Dalit community, has risen to such a high position, he said.

The top law officer hailed the CJI for his magnanimity and "majesty." Senior advocate Kapil Sibal, who was there in the court, asked senior lawyer Gopal Sankaranarayanan to

proceed with the matter and not to discuss the shocking episode any further.

"For us it is a forgotten chapter," the CJI reiterated and proceeded with the hearing.

Sex edu should be provided to children from younger age: SC

Sex education should be provided to children from a younger age, and not Class IX onwards, the Supreme Court has said.

A bench of Justices Sanjay Kumar and Alok Aradhe said sex education should be part of the curriculum in higher secondary schools so that young adolescents are made aware of the hormonal changes that come with puberty.

"We are of the opinion that sex education should be provided to children from a younger age and not Class IX onwards. It is for the authorities concerned to apply their mind and take corrective measures, so that children are informed of the changes that happen after puberty, and the care and cautions to be taken in relation thereto," the bench said. The top court made the observations while granting bail to a 15-year-old boy accused of offences under sections 376 (rape) and 506 (criminal intimidation) of the IPC, and Section 6 (aggravated penetrative sexual assault) of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act.

The apex court earlier directed his release on bail subject to terms and conditions to be fixed by the Juvenile Justice Board, noting that he was a minor.

Body of one missing soldier recovered in J&K's Kokernag

The body of one of the two missing soldiers was recovered from the Kokernag area in J&K's Anantnag district on Thursday, while the search operation to locate the other is on, officials said.

The body of a para-trooper, who had gone missing during an anti-terrorist operation in the upper reaches of Kokernag in south Kashmir on Tuesday, was recovered with his rucksack and service weapon intact.

Officials said the soldier, who was part of an ongoing search and cordon operation (CASO) launched earlier this week in the mountainous terrain, is believed to have died following an avalanche or snowstorm that struck the high-altitude area three days ago.

Private jet skids off runway in Farrukhabad during takeoff

A private jet carrying top executives of a food processing company had a narrow escape on Thursday after it skidded off the runway seconds after takeoff from the Mohammadabad airstrip in Uttar Pradesh's Farrukhabad district.

Officials said the aircraft, en route to Bhopal, veered off course and skidded for nearly

400 metres before coming to a halt. All passengers and crew members escaped unhurt.

According to sources, preliminary findings suggest that low air pressure in the tyres could have caused the aircraft to lose control during takeoff. A detailed investigation has been launched to determine the exact cause.

On board the aircraft were Deputy Managing Director of Woodpecker Greenagri Nutrients Private Limited Ajay Arora, SBI Head Sumit Sharma, BPO Rakesh Tiku,

along with pilots Captain Naseeb Bama and Captain Prateek Fernandes. The company's Uttar Pradesh project head, Manish Kumar Pandey, said the aircraft, identified as a VT Day jet operated by Jet Serve Aviation Private Limited, took off at around 10.30 am.

Pandey alleged pilot negligence, claiming the pilot was aware of the low tyre pressure before takeoff. "The incident could have been avoided had the issue been addressed earlier," he said.

SPARKS SP BACKLASH AT LUCKNOW RALLY

In a significant political moment that stirred the Uttar Pradesh political landscape, Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP) chief Mayawati on Thursday expressed gratitude to Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath for maintaining Dalit memorials built during her tenure while sharply criticising the Samajwadi Party (SP) for what she called its "double-faced politics".

Addressing a massive gathering in Lucknow on the 19th death anniversary of BSP founder Kanshi Ram, Mayawati acknowledged the Yogi



government's assurance that ticket revenue from visitors to Dalit parks and memorials would be used for their maintenance. "I wrote a letter to the chief minister requesting that the ticket money collected from visitors be used for upkeep. The BJP government assured us that this money would not be diverted elsewhere and they kept their word. For this, our party is thankful to them," she said.

Her remarks, seen as an unusual gesture of appreciation towards the ruling BJP, created a political buzz across the state, prompting a swift reaction from the SP.

EU chief comfortably survives third confidence vote in a year

The European Union's top official comfortably survived on Thursday two more votes of no confidence, as an overwhelming number of EU lawmakers rejected censure motions against her.

In the votes on European Commission President Ursula von der Leyen, 378 lawmakers rejected a far-right censure motion, with 179 in favour and 37 abstaining. On a far-left motion, 383 lawmakers voted against, with 133 in support and 78 abstentions.

Von der Leyen has now survived three no confidence votes in a year since beginning her second 5-year term at the helm of the



EU's powerful executive branch. She is the first commission chief to face any such votes in more than a decade.

The commission proposes EU laws and supervises whether those that enter into force are respected. It also manages trade on behalf of the 27 member countries and is Europe's top competition regulator.

The nationalist Patriots for Europe political group insists that migration "has

exploded" under von der Leyen's leadership and threatens "our identity and security." Its members say she abandoned farmers and consumers, jeopardising food safety with pro-environment policies.

The Left group blames her for "signing off on a number of detrimental trade deals" and failing "to act against the Israeli government's systemic violations of international law in Gaza."

But von der Leyen was backed by the big pro-European centrist groups during the votes in Strasbourg, France. They hold a majority in the assembly, and accuse the fringe groups from the left and right of the political spectrum of using the censure motions for political point-scoring.

Lit Nobel for Hungarian novelist

Hungarian writer Laszlo Krasznahorkai, whose philosophical, bleakly funny novels



often unfold in single sentences, won the Nobel Prize in literature on Thursday for his "compelling and visionary oeuvre that, in the midst of apocalyptic terror, reaffirms the power of art."

"Krasznahorkai is a great epic writer in the Central European tradition that extends through Kafka to Thomas Bernhard, and is characterised by absurdism and grotesque excess," the Swedish Academy said.

US prez weighs his Nobel Prize chances

The White House pegged him as 'The Peace President' on Thursday, even as Donald Trump himself seemed sceptical about his prospects of winning the Nobel Peace Prize despite his claim of settling 'seven' global conflicts. The US President, who has repeatedly taken credit for brokering peace between India and Pakistan -- despite New Delhi's denial -- has hinted that the Norwegian Nobel Committee "will find a reason" to not consider him for the global recognition that he believes should belong to him.

This came after Trump announced that Israel and Hamas have agreed to a deal for the first phase of a ceasefire in Gaza, after days of indirect talks in Egypt.

When asked by a reporter at the White House about his chances of winning the prize that is set to be announced on Friday, Trump said, "I have no idea... Marco (Secretary of State Rubio) would tell you we settled seven wars. We're close to settling an eighth. I think we'll end up settling the Russia situation...I don't think anybody in history has settled that many," he said, referring to Washington's efforts to broker peace between Israel and Hamas and between Russia and Ukraine.

India-Pak peace claim renewed

US President Donald Trump has again claimed that he played a key role in defusing tensions between India and Pakistan by threatening to impose massive tariffs on both countries, saying the move "stopped the fighting" between the two nuclear-armed neighbours.

In an interview with Fox News on Wednesday, Trump said his "ability" to use trade and tariffs as diplomatic leverage helped bring "peace to the world" in multiple conflict zones.

US dismisses diplomat for affair with Chinese woman

The State Department said on Wednesday that it has fired a US diplomat over a romantic relationship he admitted having with a Chinese woman alleged to have ties to the Chinese Communist Party.

The dismissal is believed to be the first of its kind for violating a ban on such relationships that was introduced late last year under the Biden administration.

The Associated Press reported earlier this year that in the waning days of Democrat Joe Biden's presidency, the State Department imposed a ban on all American government personnel in China, as well as family members and contractors with security clearances, from any romantic or sexual relationships with Chinese citizens.

Tommy Pigott, a State Department spokesman, said in

a statement that the diplomat in question was dismissed from the foreign service after President Donald Trump and Secretary of State Marco Rubio reviewed the case and determined that he had "admitted concealing a romantic relationship with a Chinese national with known ties to the Chinese Communist Party."

"Under Secretary Rubio's leadership, we will maintain a zero-tolerance policy for any employee who is caught undermining our country's national security," Pigott said.

The statement did not identify the diplomat, but he and his girlfriend had been featured in a surreptitiously filmed video posted online by conservative firebrand James O'Keefe.

In Beijing, a Chinese government spokesperson declined to comment on what he said is a domestic US issue.

Rajnath & Australian FM discuss ways to boost ties

Defence Minister Rajnath Singh and Australia's Minister for Foreign Affairs Penny Wong held a meeting in Canberra on Thursday and discussed ways to strengthen growing Comprehensive Strategic Partnership. Penny Wong called India and Australia joint custodians of the Indian Ocean.

"Had a good meeting with Australia's Foreign Minister Penny Wong in Canberra," Rajnath Singh posted on X.

Sharing details regarding the meeting on X, Directorate of Public Relations, Ministry of Defence wrote, "Raksha Mantri Shri Rajnath Singh met Australia's Foreign Minister Penny Wong in Canberra. The leaders discussed ways to strengthen the growing India-Australia Comprehensive Strategic Partnership and deepen cooperation across key sectors

including trade, technology, connectivity, and regional security." Notably, India and Australia elevated their bilateral relationship from a Strategic Partnership to a Comprehensive Strategic Partnership (CSP) in 2020. Penny Wong noted that India and Australia share a region and a future.

Sharing pictures of the meeting on X, she wrote, "Australia and India are joint custodians of the Indian Ocean. We share a region and we share a future. Today, I welcomed Defence Minister Rajnath Singh to discuss our partnership, which helps ensure our region is peaceful, stable and prosperous." Earlier in the day, Rajnath Singh held "productive" bilateral meetings with Australian Prime Minister Anthony Albanese and Defence Minister Richard Marles to explore new avenues for strengthening defence cooperation between the two nations.
